# "Cannot open backup device" message when trying to back up SQL database

## Symptom

When running Database Backup in SQL Server the following error message appears:

"Backup failed for server "XXXXXX". (Microsoft.SqlServer.Express.Smo)"

Additional Information: System.Data.SqlClient.SqlError: Cannot Open Backup Device "C:\...". Operating System Error 5(Access Denied.).(Microsoft.SqlServer.Express.Smo)

Substitute your database server name for "XXXXXX".

#### Resolution

1) In Control Panel, open Administrative Tools.

- 2) Open Services.
- 3) Right-click the SQL Server(MSSQLSERVER) service and select Properties.
- 6) Select the Log On tab.
- 7) Make sure that the **Local System Account** radio button is selected.
- 8) If necessary click [Apply] and then [OK].

9) Right-click the SQL Server(MSSQLSERVER) service and select Restart.

## Additional Information

This should only happen if the user is trying to back up the database to a folder other than the default SQL Backup folder.

*Note:* Make sure you have access to write to the folder where the database is being backed up.
