# Error Installing OnGuard on Windows Vista Business Edition

## Symptom

The following error message is displayed when opening the installation log file during the installation of OnGuard client software on a computer running Windows Vista.

"Verify that the specified log file location exists and is writable."

#### Resolution

This error occurs when a user logged into Windows Vista does not have proper permissions for Windows Installer to create the installation log specified in the **setup.ini** file.

*Note:* The path to the installation log is **%WINDIR%\6\_0\_Installation.log**.

To resolve the issue, complete the following steps.

- 1) Examine the installation disc using Windows Explorer.
- 2) In the root directory of the installation disc, right-click on the **setup.exe** file, then select **Run as Administrator**.
- 3) If prompted, enter a User Name and Password.

Setup should complete with no further errors.

### **Applies To**

OnGuard (All versions) Windows Vista

#### Additional Information

This error does not occur if the current user has proper user permissions. If using Windows Vista, OnGuard setup requires that the current user have administrative privileges.
